As the seasons change, the long days of summer turn to the colorful fall days, leaving us with great memories and new expectations. The vineyards have produced wonderful looking grapes and are very optimistic about our harvest with only 2-3 weeks remaining. We have processed Marquette (Nana's Kiss and Big Lake) and our small Traminette field, but our largest harvests will be the Riesling, Cabernet Franc and Chambourcin. The remainder of our wine needs are provided by local vineyards

The summer and fall music series were a great success with outstanding performances and delicious food. We have one more Sunday event on September 25 with Tricks Trio and La Chula food truck. We are already in the planning stages for next year. Expect Wednesday music and food trucks every week from mid June until end of August with a shorter fall music series. The 9th Anniversary party will be Sunday, July 16.

The 2021 Riesling harvest was also very good and allowed to create both a Dry Riesling and a Semi-Dry Riesling from 100% of our grapes this year. This was very exciting as it was the first time we were able to accomplish this since 2016. To help differentiate our estate grown grapes we have created new labels with the Fennville AVA (American Viticulture Area) designation. The Fennville AVA is the 3rd oldest AVA in the country and is a subset of the Lake Michigan Shore AVA we also use.
